All Local Workforce Development Boards (LWDBs), except LWDB 3, are considered Metro and use the Metro LLSIL figures. LWDB 3 is considered Non-Metro and uses the Non-Metro LLSIL figures.

CareerSource Pasco Hernando uses the 200% LLSIL Metro guidance for family size and income. Income is calculated using the most recent **gross wage** income in the household for the most recent 26 weeks. Income must be proven using pay stubs, statement from current or previous employer of gross wages if paystubs are not available and or applicant statements of weeks with no income. All income in the household will be counted. (26 weeks gross wages added together then multiplied by 2. The total amount must be at or less than the dollar amount for family size under 200% for eligibility) Low Income Adult eligibility criteria is only used when SNAP and or Unemployment Compensation is not the determining eligibility factor.

If using the LLSIL to determine eligibility for WIOA Low Income Adult, family size must be proven with the file. This means all family members with the household must have at least one of the follow documents in the file. Birth for all household members, Decree of court, disabled, divorce degree, land lord statement, lease, marriage certificate, most recent tax return supported by the IRS documents (form letter 1722) and or applicant statement.
